GENERAL TRIP INFORMATION

- 1. Although trip timings and costs advertised are based on Bristol area departures, fuel/train fare to an advertised departure point from Cardiff and Newport will be paid by the Society upon agreement with the Events Organiser. If you live outside the areas served by these points but on route for a trip please contact Roy Morris to arrange a pick up point that is mutually convenient.
- 2. The fare structure is as follows:

ADULT - FULL FARE.

CHILD - QUARTER FARE.

TRIP MEMBER - AS ABOVE + £2.

A child is a person who has not yet reached their seventeenth birthday and is still in full time education. People who are not Society members or family members will have their fares increased by the trip-member rate (£2 per day).

- 3. The discounts highlighted above for family members refer to travel costs only. Accommodation and Permits will be charged at cost price.
- 4. Members who wish to go on a trip must contact Roy Morris prior to the book by date to confirm that they still intend to go on the trip.
- 5. Where a trip is organised with an itinerary to a specific area, it may sometimes be possible to drop off a member en route. This is known as the Trip Flyer option. Availability and exact duration of stay will be at the discretion of the Events Organiser. The fare for this option will be negotiable, depending on the drop off point and seat availability.

- 16/12 Two DRS livery loco records were: 66419 with 6F90 Avonmouth Uskmouth P.S. coal (being loaded here due to flooding on the Portbury branch) passing Brentry at 11:44 and 66422 on 6Z39 13:25 Avonmouth West Wharf Didcot loaded stone which was recorded passing Brentry at 11:25.
- 01/12 Locos present in the bulk handling terminal during the afternoon were recorded as follows: 66046/069/108/133.
- **03/01** Having passed Filton Abbeywood at 11:53, 66143 arrived on a three HTA wagon Barton Hill Avonmouth trip.
- 05/01 59204 worked 6Z83 Avonmouth West Wharf Dagenham loaded stone.
- **07/01** 66108 departed on a 4E66 13:58 Avonmouth Scunthorpe train of HTAs being noted passing Westerleigh junction at 14:00, going onto the Gloucester line.
- 13/01 66068 was on the 6A83 13:30 Avonmouth West Wharf West Drayton ARC loaded stone.
- 17/01 66615 powered the 6Z39 Avonmouth Didcot loaded stone, whilst most unusually 66192 was noted here 'off route' with the 6V51 Warrington Arpley Portbury empty car train passing Hallen Marsh at 08:00.
- 26/01 DRS livery 66415 worked 6Z39 Avonmouth Stoke Gifford loaded stone. 29/01 Both No1 and 2 loading silos were noted undergoing heavy maintenance

and closed to rail loading during the day.

17/12 Pathfinder Tour's 'Festive Jingle Jangle' (1Z65 06:27 Westbury - Edge Hill sidings (13:16) was worked by 66098 departing Parkway at 07:24 (right time). 66206 returned the trip as 1Z67 18:12 Crewe sidings -

Westbury (22:53) with locos 31601, 60011 and 92037 also featuring over several different routes in the area during the day.

Other reports for the day included: 66238 + 66080 + 66002 + 66162 + 66037 + 66043 + 66061 + 66100 + 66108 + 66213 which ran 0X12 12:44 Newport ADJ - Westbury light (five locos carrying on to Eastleigh from Westbury for use on week-end track work between Yeovil and Castle Cary), 66623 which travelled 0Y27 Stoke Gifford - Newton Abbot light returning a 6Y27 15:18 rail train from Hackney yard - Ashchurch (noted Temple Meads at 17:20) and two Stoke Gifford afternoon coal empty arrivals: 66526 - 4V06 ex. 08:53 from Rugeley P.S. and 66419 - 4V46 ex. 11:15 from Rugeley P.S.

- 18/12 Engineering train reports included: 66621 6W35 06:30 Maindee East junction Westbury formed MHAs and MTAs (running over 60 minutes late), 66623 6Y27 09:00 Cheltenham Lansdown Road junction Westbury (noted near Bath at 10:02), 66549 tnt 66598 6Y33 08:58 Abbotswood junction Taunton Fairwater yard track replacement train with the usual HQA, JJA and YKA wagons (noted passing near Bath at 10:44). At 22:30, Stoke Gifford downside held: 66419, 66526, 66569, 66601, 66621, 66623, 66956, 70002.

 20/12 66001 passed Filton Abbeywood at 13:20 with a single steel carrier presumably the Barton Hill shunt 'barrier'. The wagon was believed to be
- heading back to South Wales. **23/12** 66613 arrived light-engine at 16:50 to join already stabled: 66510, 66569, 66598, 66606, 66621, 66623. All of these locos (excluding 66569) had earlier arrived as a 0Z74 15:00 Taunton Fairwater Stoke Gifford

move.

- **24/12** 66112 + 66104 + 66188 + 66105 + 66187 passed Filton Abbeywood at 13:17 running as 0X12 Newport ADJ Westbury yard. At 15:15, Stoke Gifford downside held: 66535, 66542, 66549, 66555, 66559, 66598, 66606, 66620, 66621, 66623, 70002.
- 66549 + 66623 later top n'tailed a 6Y80 Newport ADJ Didcot departmental for the Xmas period track work passing Patchway at 23:23. 66549 + 66598 + 66606 + 66623 also ran light-engine to Newport for PW works trains. 26/12 66598 passed Patchway at 06:29 on a 6Y62 Newport ADJ Didcot (Milton Estate) engineers.
- 27/12 59201 worked a morning 6B65 Westbury Newport ADJ departmental returning light-engine. Due to track work between Swindon and Parkway the 6B33 13:20 Theale Margam empty fuel tanks with 60071 was routed via the Berks & Hants, Trowbridge and Bath, being recorded passing Keynsham at 15:18 (3 late) and Patchway at 16:22.
- **28/12** DBS livery 59206 worked a 6B65 Westbury Newport ADJ departmental passing near Bath at 12:00 and Patchway at 12:23. 60071 departed Westerleigh on a morning 6B25 11:18 (MO) Westerleigh Robeston fuel tank empties.
- A freight diversion was the 4051 Wentlooge Millbrook containers with 66954, which saw a loco run-round at Swindon and the train proceed on wards via Thingley junction (12:15 3 late) and Melksham to Westbury. 70010 was also noted passing Patchway at 16:11 with coal empties for Stoke Gifford. For this part of the Christmas and New Year period, First/GW were operating a reduced timetable with SWT running a Saturday only timetable. 29/12 Having departed at 12:04, 66533 passed Filton Abbeywood at 13:13 with a diverted 4051 Wentlooge Millbrook loaded container service and 60071 was later noted passing Keynsham at 15:15 (right time) on the 6B33 Theale Margam fuel tank empties which had travelled via the Berks & Hants, Trowbridge and Bath. Other reports for the day included: 59204 with

- 6B65 11:30 Westbury Newport ADJ departmental noted passing Filton Abbeywood at 12:21, the loco later returning light to Westbury and coal empty arrivals at Stoke Gifford: 66585 at 13:46 (4V06) and 70010 at 15:37 (4V22).
- 31/12 During the afternoon period at Stoke Gifford 'downside': 66606, 66618, 66622, 70010 were all stabled with arrivals: 66618 (4V06) and 66595 (4V46) on coal empties.
- 01/01 A view of Stoke Gifford downside during the evening found the following present: 66515, 66585, 66618 (all stabled on coal empties) along with 66622, 70010.
- **02/01** 143621, which had suffered damage in an incident in the Severn Tunnel during early December worked the 2C77 13:00 Cardiff Central Exeter St. David's First/GW service, this bringing to an end the regular use of the Class in the Bristol area after nearly 20 years 143616 was in use on the Bristol Severn Beach branch line on the final day of Heritage DMU operation over this route on 26/09/92 (see Magazine 249 October 1992).
- **03/01** Strong winds and rain caused problems, in several areas with a 50 mph speed restriction being brought in as a safety precaution due to flooding in some areas. One of the usual locations prone to flooding at Chipping Sodbury tunnel saw some diversions via Bath and Box, the 1L94 19:29 Swansea Paddington First/GW HST service being recorded as running this way. The route was however reopened later into the evening. At Parkway, Stoke Gifford sidings; 66545, 66555, 70006, 70011 were found to be present during the early evening.
- **04/01** Flooding between Parkway and Swindon, in the Chipping Sodbury area was still causing delays of up to 20 minutes. 60054 brought in a retimed 6B16 Robeston Westerleigh loaded tanks service passing Yate at 04:33, the loco later working the balancing return 6B25 11:18 (MO) Westerleigh Robeston fuel tank empties. 70011 was a arrival later at Stoke Gifford on 4V47 11:15 coal empties from Rugeley P.S.
- **05/01** 60081 ran 0F85 Westerleigh Newport light engine being noted passing Parkway at 15:30 and returned the following day through Parkway at 14:25.
- **07/01** A 0012 Newport ADJ Westbury /Eastleigh light loco move was noted passing Marshfield (between (Cardiff and Newport) at 11:45 and Patchway at 12:25 formed 66005+66011+66106+66184+66232. 66552 later arrived at Stoke Gifford on 6V60 15:25 stone empties ex. Theale.
- 08/01 At 13:30, Stoke Gifford sidings held: 66555, 66564, 66585, 70002.
- **09/01** DRS livery 66419 passed Yate at 15:25 with 4V47 11:15 Rugeley P.S. Stoke Gifford coal empties. The loco ran light to Taunton Fairwater during the following morning passing Uphill junction (Weston-super-Mare) at 07:54.
- 13/01 Colas duo 47727 + 47749 worked 0Z47 Washwood Heath Westbury light engine (reported Cheltenham 10:59 18 early) for PW work in the area (see Westbury notes & news). Later, the NRMT HST set was noted passing Parkway at 11:55 working the 1Z20 Swansea Derby RTC part of the usual FO diagram. The intermediate coaches were recorded as: 977984, 975814, 975994, 975984, 975995, although our correspondent over looked taking the power car numbers!
- A loco failure report was 66607 on the 6M36 Westbury 'la Farge' Earles (Hope sidings), close to the works, 66506 being sent as the rescue loco, the train being later seen in the Bristol area over 180 minutes late with

66607 'dit' taking the normal route via Day's curve, Patchway, the Severn tunnel and the Marches.

14/01 Pathfinder Tour's first outing of the year was the 'Abercot Generator' (1Z52 07:22 Parkway - Appleford sidings) which was worked throughout by 66002, the ECS arriving as 5Z52 05:09 Eastleigh - Parkway (due 07:15), the train departing here at 07:25 (3 late). The tour later passed through the area again being noted at Patchway at 14:47 (30 late) and East Usk at 15:02, as 1Z55 12:27 Appleford - Aberthaw, the return being 1Z56 16:29 Aberthaw - Oxford (via the Vale of Glamorgan line and Barry). The train's c/stock formation was reported as: 6310, 35469, 3110, 3123, 3147, 1671, 4949, 4991, 4959, 5366.

Another report for the day was Colas 66847 noted departing Parkway at 08:33 (11 early) and passing Stapleton road at 08:42 (10 early) on a 0Z49 08:07 Gloucester - Eastleigh (11:41) light loco move.

Two other light-engine move records for the day were: 0012 (0X12 Ex. Newport ADJ) Margam - Eastleigh yard - 66031 + 66087 (both ex. Margam) 66078 + 66095 + 66023 + 66169 + 66109 (reported East Usk at 12:49) and 0Y27 Stoke Gifford - Newton Abbot - 66617 for a return 6Y27 17:17 Hackney yard - Ashchurch rail train. 158884 was the day's SWTs 'hire' unit being noted working the 2E18 08:38 Westbury - Gloucester and 2089 10:42 return to Weymouth.

- 15/01 PW train reports included: DBS 66109 6W30 11:50 Bridgend Westbury (formed JNAs with spoil and ballast and track panels), 66031 6W31 12:25 Bridgend Oxford Hinksey yard, 6W32 66046 top n'tail 66154 13:20 Bridgend Oxford Hinksey yard, 66089 6X44 13:00 Bridgend Oxford Hinksey yard (point wagons). FLHH 66617 6Y27 08:50 Cheltenham Newton Abbot (Hackney yard) reported Westerleigh junction 08:05 (80 early) and Yatton 12:23 (72 early), the loco later returning light to Stoke Gifford. Also during the morning Colas pairing 66846 + 66847 passed Parkway at 09:46 heading 0Z46 light to South Wales and at 15:20 Stoke Gifford sidings held: 66420, 66553, 66558, 66598.
- 17/01 60011 was a stranger on the 6B49 Llanwern Swindon stores yard loaded steel, the return 6B50 empties being noted passing Parkway at 16:19. Also during the morning, Colas 66846 ran as a 0Z26 Ashford C.S. Margam light loco move.
- **18/01** The 1L42 07:30 Carmarthen Paddington First/GW service was diverted via Yate passing here at 10:12 reason unknown.
- 20/01 A new DBS Friday Only freight service for the area: 6042 11:31 Halewood Southampton Eastern Dock operated behind 66111. The working which today conveyed 88 Range Rover Evoques, operates Monday Saturday normally from Birmingham via Banbury and Oxford. Some local timings for this service are: Gloucester 16:55, Bristol Parkway (down yard crew change) 18:07 18:37, Filton Abbeywood 18:40. The train then continues onwards via Day's curve, Bath and Westbury. It is interesting to note the 6042 head code was last used in the area on one of the Avonmouth Furzebrook empty lpg tank workings.
- 21/01 Light loco moves during the afternoon recorded: 0X12 Margam Westbury formed 66087 + 66096 + 66004 + 66092 + 66169 + 66074 + 66114, passing Newport at 14:46, Patchway 15:14, Keynsham 15:40 and arriving in Westbury at 16:15 (where some of the locos were moved on to Eastleigh). It is interesting to note the convoy ran as a 0B19 move between Margam and Tondu, and 0Y34 18:01 Stoke Gifford Westbury formed 66621 + 66589 + 66590.

Other reports for the day were: 66419 (4V46), 66523 (4V20), 66618 (4V06) all on Stoke Gifford coal empty arrivals, 66519 on 6V60 Angerstein Wharf - Pengam stone empties and 66618 with a 6Y27 Newton Abbot Hackney yard - Stoke Works junction rail train.

22/01 Some Sunday PW train observations included: 66074 - 6W35 11:15
Bridgend - Westbury (formed with MHA, MFA, MTA wagons), 66058 - 6W36 12:25
Bridgend - Westbury (formed with MHA and MTA wagons - loaded spoil), 66005
tnt 66017 - 6W37 13:10 Bridgend - Westbury, 66054 - 6W38 14:15 Bridgend Westbury, 66089 - 6W49 16:56 Bridgend - Oxford Hinksey yard. Trains 6W35 6W37 all arrived late during the previous evening or in the early hours at
Leckwith junction to enter the occupation and saw a loco run-round or
reverse at Briton Ferry, whilst 6W49 ran round at Swansea Burrows sidings.
Also, 6W39 20:00 Bridgend - Bescot with 66091 and 6W40 23:30 Bridgend Bescot with 66141 both ran and returned via Tondu.

Another report for the day was GBRf owned 66745 (carrying Colas colours) on a 6E37 Cardiff Tidal sidings - Peterborough working formed of 6 VTG empty green bogie box wagons, being noted passing Patchway at 15:03 and Didcot at 16:12. 66416 with 66523 and 66590 were noted stabled at Parkway at 12:00.

23/01 A 1Q13 Derby RTC - Tyseley test train formed with NR Class 37 97303 (with dept c/stock 72616, 72639, 977997, 9701) was noted passing Cheltenham at 13:17 heading to Newport for a reverse move, prior to passing Chepstow at 14:39, Charfield 15:25, Yate 15:31 for a reverse at Temple Meads. The return was later recorded through Yate heading north at 16:52 (3 late). 66548 was a late afternoon arrival on 4V47 Rugeley P.S. - Stoke Gifford coal empties (reported Charfield 15:17).

24/01 66847 failed in the Severn Tunnel on 6078 Dollands Moor bound export steel. 66069 off a Didcot - Avonmouth coal service was the 1Z99 rescue loco.

25/01 66504 worked a diverted 4V50 Millbrook - Wentlooge container service via Bath, passing here at 06:30 (42 late). This service was again routed this way during the following day.

26/01 66598 + 66616 top n'tailed a 6Y33 06:42 Parkway - Taunton Fairwater yard track replacement train (due 05:59) and later 66617 worked a 6Y27 21:05 Newton Abbot Hackney yard - Westerleigh junction rail train. Also, 66549 powered 6V44 Angerstein Wharf - Barrow Road stone empties.

27/01 66617 returned the 6Y27 'slinger' wagon rail train as a 05:30 Charfield - Newton Abbot Hackney yard working, the loco then returning a 6Z28 17:05 train to Eastleigh East yard (21:58), instead of returning to Stoke Gifford light as originally booked.

The second Friday Only 6042 11:31 Halewood - Southampton Eastern dock car train operated behind 66221. 70003 and 70016 were present in Stoke Gifford down sidings during the afternoon.

28/01 66420 + 66542 arrived in Stoke Gifford downside at 14:08 as 0C30 a light loco move from Bristol West (Railport). Two afternoon empty coal arrivals were recorded: 66524 on 4V06 Rugeley P.S. - Stoke Gifford at 13:17 (reported as running nearly three hours late) and 66552 on 4V20 08:00 Fiddler's Ferry - Stoke Gifford at 14:44. The latter working had seen a loco swap presumably in the Crewe area as 70015 had taken out the previous evening's 6M02 20:45 departure off Portbury which forms the 4V20 return empties.

29/01 Stoke Gifford sidings held: 66420, 66523, 66524, 66542, 66618.

30/01 31465 worked a 1Q06 15:39 Derby RTC - Temple Meads structural

gauging train (formed with dept c/stock: 99666, 460000, 975280, 975081, 9708) being booked to include Gloucestershire branch lines en route. Having visited the Sharpness branch (booked 19:48 - 20:16) the train was reported passing Cheltenham north at 22:08 (2 early) and down 22:21 (1 early) following a reverse in Alstone loop, then Yate at 23:00 (3 late) for the Westerleigh branch line returning at 23:35 (3 late) and departing for Temple Meads 'wrong line' at 23:40 (72 early) having not covered the Tytherington branch as booked - reason unknown..

31/01 Having arrived the previous afternoon, 37409 + saloon coach 975025 Caroline worked a high mileage 2Z02 07:30 Cardiff Canton - Bristol Parkway, via Parkway, the GWML, Acton High level, Willesden SW sidings (reverse), Kew East junction, Hounslow, Woking, Basingstoke, Southampton (reverse), Basingstoke, Reading, Swindon (reported 16:06 - 18 late) and then 'off route' in Temple Meads at 18:48, assumed to reverse the train. A booked visit and reverse at Yate did not take place.

Another report for the day was: 66616 + 66617 top n'tailing a 6Y11 Taunton Fairwater - Chipping Sodbury HOBC working (via Westbury).

Bristol Temple Meads, Barton Hill and Kingsland Road

16/12 Despite as having reported 143617 as the last class member working in the Bristol area, Severn Tunnel incident damaged 143621 was still present near the wheel lathe at St. Phillips Marsh on this date. Also at St. Phillip's Marsh during the morning, 08822 was active shunting barrier vans 6330 and 6348 (the latter a long term resident here) ready for Colas 47739 + 47749 to top n'tail as a 5Z47 11:19 move to Eastleigh Works to collect HST buffet coaches for a move to Kilmarnock for modifications to normal passenger stock. The working, which was routed via a reverse at Bristol West was recorded passing Temple Meads at 11:40.

Over at Barton Hill, 66004 was shunting the water cannon wagon ready to depart during the afternoon being latter recorded as passing Parkway at 14:20 and Sprinter coach 55300 (150001) was noted moving on it's own carrying a former Central green livery one side and a rubbed down masking tape First/GW 'undercoat' livery on the other!

Later at Temple Meads, test unit 950001 passed on 2Q08 06:30 Westbury - Plymouth (via the Mendip quarries, Newbury and Reading) being reported passing Highbridge at 16:15 and later 66601 which was noted at 16:20 on a 6Z85 Taunton Fairwater - Taunton Fairwater HOBC turning move (via Bath and Westbury).

47701 is now in a non-authentic two tone green colour scheme, and was carrying tinsel wrapped on it's front end hand rails! There were several items unidentified from this 'view from train' report including two Wickham trollies and two coaches.

Both 60150 and 60673 were assumed only as on the inside of a second row of stock.

977353 + 10611 + 69310 were all in use as a buffet /café and associated stores vehicle close to the Meldon viaduct.

The loco maintenance shed at Meldon was reported as containing an industrial steam loco: a Hudswell Clarke in pieces (a long term restoration project!) and diesel Flying Falcon (JF 422016/62) - a very underpowered loco for use on the line - but at in working order! coach: (13436) under a full overhaul.

The railway hope soon to have a fully working two (or three coach) 'thumper' unit formed: 60146 + 60677 + 60827 (205028), although the costs of replacing some of the small broken windows in the centre coach is proving expensive.

76747 + 62385 (both ex. emu set 1399) were from the Pontypool & Blaenavon Railway, having previously being located at Meldon.

Coach RDB975046 (LAB 11) is ex. Nottingham Heritage Centre, Ruddington. The train shuttles over the December period were operating from Okehampton as far as the former Bow station site (although no alighting was allowed here due to the condition of the platform) towards Crediton, and then back to Meldon Quarry (via Okehampton).

At Meldon Quarry the station had just survived a recent landslide which had wiped out and closed part of the nearby Granite Way public footpath and cycleway. Rebuilding repairs were underway with a detour available over the station platform on non rail operating days otherwise it was a longish diversion over fields to by-pass the site.
