NOTES & NEWS for this month

Bristol Parkway, Stoke Gifford, Pilning and Westerleigh

20/08 66622, 66419 and 66615 were stabled in the yard; Having stabled at Stoke Gifford over the weekend, 70007 powered the MO additional morning Wentloog-Southampton container service. Later, 56303 headed a 6Z93 1234 Cardiff-Rotherham steel terminal train of scrap empties (via Oxford) in a revised path, being recorded passing Marshfield around 3 hours late at 1520, Patchway 1601, Hullavington 1648 (112 late) and Swindon 1722 (127 late). The 56 now carries a 'Brian' name sticker or nameplate? 21/08 66622 and 66419 were again stabled in the yard

22/08 GBRf 66729 on the 6E01 diverted Cardiff docks - Peterborough oil tanks made a rare appearance through Patchway at 0946. Later, 60063 was on the 6B33 Theale-Robeston empty fuel tanks and 37611 + 37610 powered the 6M67 Bridgwater - Crewe coal yard nuclear flasks noted in Temple Meads at 1248 and Parkway at 1320

25/08 60063 worked the 6B33 Theale - Margam empty fuel tanks whilst at 1350 Stoke Gifford downside held: 66419/515/522/957.

26/08 At 1620 Stoke Gifford downside held the following: 66415/419 (arrived 0Y12 ex Westbury with 66957)/508/532 (allox 0L32 to Bristol Railport on 27/08, with 66566)/566 (allox 0L32 to Bristol Railport with 66532)/ 603/615/622/957(arrived 0Y12 ex Westbury with 66419). The 0L32 locos were to work: 4L30 0903-Felixstowe (66566) and 4024 1100 - Grain (66532)

28/08 66524 66622 and 66419 were stabled in the yard; 60063 passed Pilning at 1041 with a very late running 6A11 Robeston - Theale loaded fuel tank train being later reported departing Bathampton loop at 1245. The reason for the late running was due to no relief driver being available at Margam.

Later, 66846 worked an early afternoon 6Z52 Chirk - Gloucester New yard empty log wagon positioning move and 66555 was an evening arrival in Bristol on a re-timed (from 1030) 6Z43 1630 Washwood Heath CMX - Stoke

Gifford train of 18 empty HIA wagons being reported as passing King's Norton at 1705 (5 late).

31/08 70009 passed Bristol Parkway at 1053 with 4051 Wentloog -Southampton; 66622 and 66555 were stabled in the yard in the morning. Later that evening 66415 was on the front of a coal train departing at 1952 presumably with empties to Portbury, whilst 70002 had joined 66555 stabled in the yard

01/09 66556 66622 and 66957 were stabled in the yard. The FLHH 6L81 1304 (SO) Cardiff Tidal - Dagenham empty scrap wagons was noted passing Patchway at 1545 with 66601 + 66618 being later reported departing Bathampton loop at 1556 for Swindon via Box. The second loco had arrived in South Wales via Bristol Parkway on a 6Z91 Tees yard - Cardiff Tidal train of empty scrap box wagons passing Patchway at 0843. During the evening period, Stoke Gifford downside held: 66514 66555 66957 and 70017 (ex 4V50 Southampton - Wentloog containers).

03/09 66555 66514 66601 and 66618 were stabled in the yard **05/09** 150233 suffered a serious seized transmission failure and wheel flat in the Severn Tunnel area during the late morning, which saw at least two freight diversions via Gloucester: Shanks livery 66522 passing Parkway at 1154 on the 6M04 1050 Portbury - Rugeley PS loaded coal and 66846 on the 6Z52 Chirk - Teigngrace log empties, passing Chepstow at 1229, Lawrence Hill 1359 and Bridgwater 1448.

06/09 The failed unit 150233 was stored in a siding at Severn Tunnel junction, near the M5 road over bridge, and was planned to be move to St.Phillips Marsh using a pair of wheel skates during the morning. 07/09 66099 passed Filton Abbeywood at 1825 with the 6042 1131 (FO) Halewood (Jaguar) - Southampton Eastern dock loaded cars. This was also reported a runner, around the same time on 14/09 with 66090.

08/09 66536 passed Bristol Parkway at 0743 with 4V50 Southampton -Wentloog liner; At 1600 the downside at Stoke Gifford held the following: 66415/514/532 66536/548/553/555/957 70010.

15/09 At 1400 Stoke Gifford downside held: 66501/516/548/597/610.
17/09 70003 was in Stoke Gifford yard moving wagons at 17.05; Much anticipated new Colas power for the Teigngrace logs 56094 ran 0Z50 1000 Eastleigh - Cardiff Canton light-engine for driver training. The loco passed Salisbury at 1021 (20 early), Bath 1114 (24 early), Patchway 1146 (23 early), Pilning 1150 (40 early - no loop stop) and Severn tunnel junction 1159 (43 early).

18/09 66539 passed Westerleigh Junction at 1850 with 4057 Wentloog -Southampton; Colas 56094 returned, being noted passing East Usk yard at 1016 running light from Cardiff Canton to Gloucester yard to collect 8 new timber carrying wagons (29 of which had been delivered as a 6Z47 Dolland's Moor - Gloucester move, via Kemble on 31/08 by 47739) as 6Z30 1212 Gloucester New yard - Barry, but was heavily delayed for an unspecified reason reaching Westerleigh junction at 1409 (87 late), passing Patchway at 1418 (90 late) and Severn Tunnel junction at 1429 (87 late). The loco then ran 0Z51 Leckwith South junction - Gloucester New Yard for the Teigngrace empty log service during the following day. Another freight report for the day was 60007 with the afternoon 6B33 Theale - Robeston empty fuel tanks.

The following have been noted: 60007/011/040/079/091/099.

The 6E41 is reported to have a revised 1215 departure time for Lindsey after the 6B13 loaded tanks from Robeston have arrived.

Bristol Temple Meads, Barton Hill, Kingsland Road

20/08 47500 returned the previous days Royal Duchy stock as 5Z94 1035
Kingsland Road - Southall passing Oldfield Park, Bath at 1048.
21/08 Two morning engineering train reports were: 66610 + 66623 passing
Bedminster at 0652 with a return 6Y11 HOBC working to Taunton Fairwater
and 66548 down Temple Meads at 0921 on a 6Z27 Westbury - Newton Abbot
Hackney yard rail train.

22/08 Colas 66846 passed Yatton at 1213 with 6Z52 0813 Chirk – Teigngrace empty log carriers. A 5Z20 0858 Kilmarnock – Laira (2337) HST stock move caused much interest as Harry Needle Company 20311 + 20314 (now in a bright orange livery with yellow ends!) arrived in Scotland for the move south. However, a motive power swap took place at Washwood Heath in favour of Devon & Cornwall green livery 31602 and NR yellow 31601 departing at 1820 (4 early) and passing Yate at 2030 (6 late), Dr.Day's junction 2050 (7 late), Bridgwater 2125 (8 late) and Taunton 2132 (5 late). The train was formed: 6348 + 42513 (ex 40738) + 6330.

Also during the evening 66623 + 66610 top n' tailed a 6Y11 HOBC working from Taunton Fairwater yard passing Lawrence Hill at 2054.

23/08 66846 returned the 6Z53 loaded logs during the early evening. The Class 31s returned north with the two barrier vans (6330 + 6348) as 5Z56 1209 Laira - Washwood Heath (1826) being timed as passing: Hemerdon (near Plymouth) at 1215 (4 early), Dawlish 1254 (4 early), Cowley Bridge (Exeter) 1316 (2 early), Taunton arrive 1343 and depart 1400 (1 late), Bridgwater 1409 (1 early), Parsons Street 1441 (3 early), Filton Abbeywood 1521 (1 early) and Yate 1520 (12 early).

24/08 The Paralympic Torch arrived in Bath around 1400 on the 1C14 1230 Paddington - Bristol TM HST service carried by Steve Brunt MBE, the Bath & North-East Somerset Ambassador to the Olympics. The torch then made its way from the station to the Assembly Rooms on a horse drawn carriage. This was in fact one of four flames throughout the country marking the start of the Paralympic games.

25/08 West Coast 47245 brought in 5Z92 Southall - Kingsland Road ecs for railtour duty during the following day being reported as passing Keynsham at 1728. Pathfinder Tour's 'Carmarthen Coast Express' steam hauled trip featuring 70000 Britannia was cancelled.

27/08 47245 returned the previous day's Weymouth tour ecs as 5Z94 Temple Meads - Southall passing Bathampton junction at 1059. Being a Bank Holiday Monday, the DBS 6C49 Cardiff Tidal sidings - Exeter (Alphington Road) scrap service with 66070 was an unusual freight runner. The loaded return 6B59 departed Exeter at 1341 - 219 early! SWT's 158889 'on hire' to First/GW during the day was noted paired up with 150248 on a morning Weymouth service.

28/08 66548 worked a 6Z86 Taunton Fairwater - Taunton Fairwater HOBC wagon turning move passing Nailsea at 1508 heading towards Bristol, eventually reaching it's destination at 1728.

29/08 The days Arriva XC HST diagrams were covered with the following power cars: 43321 + 43304 - 1V44 0600 Leeds - Plymouth / 1S51 1223 Plymouth - Glasgow Central, 43303 + 43357 - 1V46 0632 York - Plymouth /1S53 1323 Plymouth - Edinburgh Waverley, 43366 + 43207 - 1V50 0606 Edinburgh Waverley - Plymouth / 1E63 1523 Plymouth - Leeds, 43378 + 43301

- 1V54 0810 Edinburgh Waverley - Plymouth / 1E73 1723 Plymouth - Leeds. The 6Z52 0836 Gloucester yard - Teigngrace empty log carriers were noted leaving Yatton loop at 1002 (14 late) and later 37610 + 37611 were paired on the 6M67 Bridgwater - Crewe coal yard nuclear flasks departing Bridgwater at 1303. BT Police are investigating a serious incident at Yatton which saw a brick thrown through the windscreen of the Voyager set working the 1V68 1508 Edinburgh Waverley - Plymouth Arriva XC service. The train was taken out of service at Yatton following the event, the driver being shaken but not injured. Arriva XC have offered a £5000 reward for information about the incident The Northern Belle was back in the area top n'tailed with the 30/08 dedicated 47790 + 47832 working 1Z45 0554 Derby - Bath and Newbury, 5Z45 1327 Newbury - Bristol TM, 5Z46 1643 Bristol TM - Bath (1654) and 1Z46 1700 Bath - Derby (0016). Train timing reports were: 1Z45 - Leamington Spa 0904 (1 early), Swindon 1048 (-), Chipping Sodbury 1108 (10 early), Bradford-on-Avon 1210 (3 early), 5Z45 - Hawkridge junction (Westbury) 1419 (3 late), Oldfield Park, Bath 1445 (3 late), 5Z46 - Keynsham 1640, 1Z46 departing Bath 1656 (4 early), Bathampton junction 1702 (3 early), Trowbridge 1715. On the freight side: 66846 was noted restarting the 6Z53 1441 Teigngrace -Carlisle (0338) loaded logs at Stapledon Road following a stop to let a Severn Beach - Temple Meads service cross in front, the train passing Narroway's Hill junction at 1742 01/09 A 'Riviera Statesman' outing 1Z21 0604 Sheffield - Kingswear and 1Z22 1656 return was top n'tailed throughout by West Coast 47786 + 47854 with c/stock: 5487, 5478, 5912, 99674, 99675, 1211, 99672, 99673, 1659, 3188, 3231, 17080. The trip was recorded as passing: Abbotswood junction 1015 (25 late) - delayed by a bridge strike in the Birmingham area, Yate 1056, Lawrence Hill 1118, Taunton 1207 and the 1Z22 return, Bridgwater 1905 and departing Temple Meads right time at 2003. Interesting rumours were circulating during the early afternoon regarding the 5Z34 1528 Southall - Bristol TM (1803) steam railtour ecs with 33025, 33029, 37516 and 47245 all available at Southall depot. However, the latter provided the power (as usual!), the other three locos being due to return as a 0945 light loco move to Carnforth on 03/09. 5Z34 was reported passing Challow at 1634 (1 late) and Bathampton junction 1715 (-). SWTs 158885 was noted 'on hire' to First/GW during the day. 02/09 What could have been a serious incident occurred at Worle during the evening, when a women in her 30s and under the influence of alcohol wandered off the end of the up station platform in the Bristol direction and was struck by the Arriva XC 1E73 1530 Penzance - Leeds service (formed with Voyager sets 220019 + 220008). She tumbled down the bank having received head injuries, emergency services taking her to Frenchay hospital in Bristol for treatment. The 1E75 was later reported as arriving in Temple Meads at 2021 (54 late) and the return Torbay Express steam excursion (1Z28 1642 Kingswear - Bristol TM) with 4464 Bittern which was held at Weston station, was noted passing Worle junction at 2022 (36 late) and Nailsea & Backwell at 2030. At least one diversion was reported via Westbury and Bath, 220028 working the 1E75 1823 Plymouth - Leeds Arriva XC service.

07/09 Having arrived in South Wales as 1Z71 Manchester Victoria - Cardiff Central, via the Marches the previous day, the 'Africa's Express'

(which carried a headboard and carriage window/door stickers) ran 1271 1305 Cardiff Central - Bristol TM top n'tailed with 47805 + 47810 passing East Usk at 1400 (37 late), Pilning 1419 (38 late) and Filton Abbeywood 1426 (34 late). The 5Z72 1430 Bristol TM - Cardiff Pengam ecs for overnight stabling was reported as around an hour down, the late running believed to be connected to problems with 47810. This train was in use on a nationwide tour celebrating the London 2012 Music Festival. Another Bristol area evening arrival was GBRf 66737 on a 5V01 1315 MRT Butterley - Barton Hill saloon coach move (LMS 6320) for a West Somerset Railway visit during the following day. The move was reported passing Westerleigh junction at 1735 (5 early), arriving Bristol Parkway up loop at 1743 (3 early) and departing at 1749 (1 early), Filton Abbeywood 1754 (-) and arriving in Temple Meads at 1804 (1 late). The GBRf saloon move formed 66737 + maroon livery 6320 continued 08/09 on it's journey, running 5Z01 1005 Barton Hill - Bristol Parkway passing Lawrence Hill at 1010 (1 early), then 2Z01 1045 Bristol Parkway - Bishop's Lydeard (1240) passing Lawrence Hill at 1059 (-), Parsons street 1119 (-), Worle junction 1135 (2 early), Bridgwater 1206 (6 early) and Norton Fitzwarren 1228 (4 early). The 2Z02 1505 Bishop's Lydeard - Bristol Parkway (1718) return which arrived in Taunton at 1522 (5 early), passed Uphill junction at 1559 (1 early) and Lawrence Hill at 1705 (1 early) the train then departing Parkway as 5M01 to Butterley at 1723 (2 early) and passing Gloucester at 1816 (2 early). Two DRS railtours in the area, and no less than five Class 47s!! 47790 + 47832 top n'tailed the Northern Belle running as 1Z78 0744 Gobowen - Bath passing Chippenham at 1146 (8 early), Bathampton junction 1159 (3 early) and Bath arriving at 1203 (3 early). The 5Z28 1212 ecs ran to Swindon passing Stapleton Road at 1231 (2 late), Parkway and Badminton. The return 5Z29 1545 Swindon - Bath ecs was logged passing Lawrence Hill at 1633 (-) and Keynsham at 1642, the 1Z79 1702 Bath - Gobowen (2210) being later reported passing Bathampton junction at 1721 (7 late). The second special was the return 'Africa's Express'-5Z73 1004 Cardiff Pengam sidings - Bristol TM (1157) with 47805 top n'tailing 47810 (which suffered problems) + 47802 (reserve loco from Crewe) with c/stock: 17077, 17056, 92904, 3333, 1203, 3386, 3345, passing East Usk at 1045 (22 late) and Lawrence Hill at 1109 (1 late). The return the 1Z73 1209 Temple Meads - Kings X (1522) was reported passing Bath at 1222 (1 late) and Chippenham 1247 (15 late). The Africa's Express had a number of celebrities on board including organizer Damon Albarn (of pop acts Blur and Gorillaz fame) and the Bombay Bicycle Club as well as several African musicians and dance artist's who performed a four hour set in the Big Top Creative Common close to Temple Meads next to the river. Also, Led Zeppelin legend bass player, John Paul Jones put in an on stage appearance during the evening! Even more Brush loco action to end the day! 47245 brought in the 'Royal Duchy' 5Z34 ex Southall seen in Bath down goods loop at 1723 and arriving in Kingsland Road sidings at 1739. It was interesting to record that the Northern Belle crossed the 'Africa's Express' under the Pixash Lane road overbridge near Keynsham at 1219 - but there was enough time to get a decent photo of each before they passed according to a photographer on the bridge at that location at the time !

10/09 Both First/GW overnight sleeper services were booked via Bristol, Bath and Swindon. 57604 - 1A40 2115 (Sun) Penzance - Paddington with

c/stock: 10532, 10616, 10601, 10589, 10584, 10225, 12161, 17175. 57602 -1C99 2350 (Sun) Paddington - Penzance with c/stock: 17174, 12100, 10219, 10534, 10612, 10563, 10612, 10563, 10594.

Later during the morning, 47245 returned the West Coast 'Royal Duchy' ecs which included steam loco 34067 Tangmere in the train's formation. 11/09 Compass Tour's 'Bath & Avon Explorer' (1250 0648 Bolton - Bristol

TM and 1Z51 1644 return) was top n'tailed by West Coast 47804 + 47854 with c/stock: 99680, 3395. 3326. 3313, 3359, W1201, 6103, 6000, W5928. The train which passed Didcot at 1221 (1 late) arrived in Temple Meads around 1330, and departed on time on the return.

Also at Temple Meads during the evening, test unit 950001 was stabled on the former Bath Road stub having worked 2Q08 0512 Derby RTC - Bristol TM (1508), booked via the Sharpness (0950 - 0954), Tytherington (1312-1322) and Westerleigh (1405 - 1410) branchlines along the way.

12/09 The 6V74 Crewe Coal yard - Bridgwater nuclear flasks with 37610 + 37682 arrived in Bridgwater late at 0825, but departed 1140 (82 early!) with two FNAs 550043 + 550054, passing Lawrence Hill at 1221. Another freight report during the day, was 66847 passing Uphill junction (Weston-super-Mare) at 1211 with 6Z52 Chirk - Teigngrace log empties. Test unit 950001 worked 2Q08 west from Bristol - Plymouth (via the Westbury area) returning through Bath for Bristol at 1005 and passing Bridgwater at 1154. The unit was booked to return north as 2Q08 0716 St.Erth - Derby RTC (1657) two days later.

Bristol Community Rail Festival

A DMU shuttle will be running from Bristol Temple Meads on Saturday 29 September. Trains will run along the Portbury Branch leaving Temple Meads at 09.05, 11.08, 12.09, 15.12 and 16.08 each trip takes approx 1 hour. All tickets have been sold (100 on each train) but there will at least be some rare photo opportunities.

The station gala at Bristol Temple Meads features stalls and information about Community Rail Partnerships throughout UK.

Flax Bourton (Bristol - Weston mainline)

The former MoD / fuel storage depot sidings were removed earlier in the year (being noted lifted in May). An attempt to reopen this site as a stone terminal late in 1999 failed due to public objections although Tarmac Quarries Ltd had purchased redundant loading equipment from Hexham (on the Carlisle - Newcastle line) for use at the location. The company, which had during late 1998 / early 1999, loaded a number of stone trains at Bristol East depot via road lorry moves from the quarry, were keen to build a connecting 1 mile long conveyer belt from their nearby Stancombe Quarry as a link to the nearby rail sidings.

Weston-super-Mare

With a plan for 900 new homes, as well as a school planned for part of the former Westlands aircraft builder airfield site, some vegetation clearance work believed linked to this project has revealed long lost sidings still in situ on the site. A mainline connection once existed on the down side between Worle and Uphill junction, on the Weston avoiding line being controlled by the Hutton signal box. Being closed in 1964, the link was lost although the former goods platform remained with it's building which is still visible on the Oldmixon site of the Winterstoke road rail over bridge.

At the town's main station a second new catering outlet opened on 03/09 to run alongside the popular 'Off The Rails' public house located on the up side platform. The Cole's Shed is open from 0700 - 1900, seven days a week and is managed by Simon Cole who helped set up the successful Strawberry Line café at Yatton railway station which was opened in January 2011. An announcement during mid September has confirmed the seaside resort will still be served by two direct trains to the Capital every week day once the forthcoming GWML electrification scheme has been completed from London - Bristol TM.

Carrying a 'Devonian Belle' headboard. The following weekend (16/09) saw 34067 Tangmere head the 'Royal Duchy' and 4464 Bittern work the final Torbay Express of 2012 season.

15/09 Having arrived during the previous evening with support coach, 70000 Britannia departed Barton Hill with 4464 Bittern and support coach M35465 during the morning as a 5Z27 move to Taunton. The pair took over the Railway Touring Company 'Mayflower' (1Z27 0646 Euston - Plymouth and 1Z28 1611 return) from 34067 Tangmere.

Tangmere with support coach 35518 was then turned on the new WSR Norton Fitzwarren triangle (becoming the first loco to do so) and returned as 5Z30 1330 Bishop's Lydeard - Barton Hill passing Bridgwater at 1409. Following the return of the 'Mayflower' and 4464 Bittern detached, Britannia returned the train solo and 4464 Bittern ran 0Z30 1839 Taunton -Barton Hill passing Uphill junction with no support coach at 1850. On the Bristol Harbour Railway, Henbury (P1940/37) was noted working trains to both the SS Great Britain and to the Create Centre along the Wapping Wharf branchline during the 08/09. This was part of Bristol's annual open building weekend. The line's other loco 34 Portbury (AE 1764/17) was noted undergoing a 10 year boiler overhaul along with work on the locos outer fire box inside the South Devon Railway works at Buckfastleigh on 22/08. New stays and boiler tubes are to be fitted to the loco which was noted in the main shop next to ex. GWR pannier tank 6412 also undergoing overhaul. The boiler of Kilmersden (P1788/29) of the Somerset & Dorset Trust at Washford was also reported as on site for attention.

The Avon Valley Railway marked the 50th Anniversary of the end of the 'Pines Express' from the Midlands - Bournemouth via the Somerset & Dorset route from Bath Green Park with a special non stop run over their line passing through Bitton station at 1515, the same booked time the train would have passed for the last time on 08/09/62.

22/08 Ex. GWR steam 3205 and 6430 were in use hauling trains. 1369
assisted with stock shunting at Buckfastleigh at the end of the day,
single car DMU W55000 being used on the final out and back passenger trip.
25/08 First/GW 150221 visited the line on a 2Z11 1705 Exeter St.Davids Staverton (via Totnes) special for a beer festival taking place in the
village of Staverton. The unit returned as the 2055 departure from
Buckfastleigh to Exeter.

Dean Forest Railway

15/09 For the diesel gala Hastings DEMU set 1001 arrived as 1Z52 0705 Hastings - Lydney junction (1228) via Swindon, Kemble and Gloucester. The unit was reported to have worked along the branch and later returned as 1Z53 1600 Lydney junction - Hastings being noted near Swindon at 1752.

Steel Blues

The Government are unveiling new plans to curb cabling theft from railway property which caused a total of 26,871 minutes of train delays during 2011. Scrap dealers could be forced to close down if stolen rail material

has been proved to have been found on their premises with the new ruling. This also covers illegal movement where a transport license could be lost by any firms concerned. Not only rail property will be covered, but also lead thefts from buildings, the theft of memorial plaques and road signs will also be investigated. First/GW reported 117 incidents of metal theft in 2011, 88 in 2010 and 61 in 2009.
