

# GENERAL TRIP INFORMATION

- 1. Although trip timings and costs advertised are based on Bristol area departures, fuel/train fare to an advertised departure point from Cardiff and Newport will be paid by the Society upon agreement with the Events Organiser. If you live outside the areas served by these points but on route for a trip please contact Roy Morris to arrange a pick up point that is mutually convenient.
- 2. The fare structure is as follows:

ADULT - FULL FARE.

CHILD - QUARTER FARE.

TRIP MEMBER - AS ABOVE + £2.

A child is a person who has not yet reached their seventeenth birthday and is still in full time education. People who are not Society members or family members will have their fares increased by the trip-member rate (£2 per day).

- 3. The discounts highlighted above for family members refer to travel costs only. Accommodation, and permits / admission fees will be charged at cost price.
- 4. Members who wish to go on a trip must contact Roy Morris prior to the book by date to confirm that they still intend to go on the trip.
- 5. Where a trip is organised with an itinerary to a specific area, it may sometimes be possible to drop off a member en route. This is known as the Trip Flyer option. Availability and exact duration of stay will be at the discretion of the Events Organiser. The fare for this option will be negotiable, depending on the drop off point and seat availability.
- 6. For members living outside the normal pick up/drop off areas it may be possible to be picked up en route. This is known as the Trip Hiker option. Fares and availability are at the discretion of the Events Organiser.

# NOTES & NEWS for this month

# Bristol Parkway, Stoke Gifford, Pilning and Westerleigh

19/09 Signalling problems between Bristol Parkway and Westerleigh junction saw Arriva / XC diversions via Newport and Chepstow during the morning with up to 60 minute delays on some services. The 6Z52 1035 Gloucester New Yard - Teigngrace empty log carriers being also affected, with 56094 making it's West of England Class debut on this train for Colas. With the problem sorted just after noon, 56094 was eventually reported through Standish junction at 1241 (117 late), Charfield 1255 (99 late), Filton Abbeywood 1317 (101 late), Bristol West junction 1327 (78 late), Uphill junction 1347 (75 late), Exeter St.Davids 1501 (41 late) and Dawlish (passing here wrong line) 1521 (26 late),

20/09 The recently introduced DBS flow - 4011 (WThFO) Didcot - Onllwyn Washery was noted during the early afternoon conveying loaded coal behind 66061. This working is believed to be for the movement of either stock piled or contaminated coal as Didcot Power station, opened in 1970 is listed for closure in March 2013 (along with Fawley Power station, Southampton) due to EU regulations. 66139 worked this train during the following day, with 66031 being recorded on this working first on 07/09/12.

Return Colas 6Z53 1441 Teigngrace - Chirk loaded logs departed at 1346 (55 early) behind 56094 and was later reported: Dawlish 1538 (2 late), Exeter St. Davids 1552 (4 late), Taunton 1624 (2 late), Bridgwater 1636 (2 late), Parsons Street 1720 (9 late), Filton Abbeywood 1744 (1 late), Magor 1811 and Cwmbran 1855. During the morning the Class 56 had run 0Z56 0920 Newton Abbot - Exeter St. Davids stabling point, departing 8 minutes early from a fuel stop returning at 1043 (53 early) back at Newton Abbot. A single loaded log carrier has been reported in the Taunton Fairwater yard head shunt this being the defective wagon that was removed from the heavily delayed train on 13/09 (see the October 2012 Magazine). Another freight report for the day was 37259 + 37607 passing Parkway at 1320 on 6M67 Bridgwater - Crewe Coal sidings nuclear flasks. This pairing had made a rare class debut on the 4V38 Daventry - Wentloog TESCOs container train two day's earlier in place of the usual Class 66.

60007 powered the afternoon 6B33 Theale - Robeston empty fuel bogie tanks and 66142 was reported through Pilning during the early evening on an additional 6Z39 Newport ADJ - St.Blazey freight formed of 18 china clay wagons.

22/09 The 0012 Margam - Westbury light loco convoy ran for a second consecutive Saturday being noted passing Filton Abbeywood at 1248 formed: 66134 + 66106 + 66047 + 66020 + 66007.

At 1615 Stoke Gifford downside held nine locos: 66413 66520 66527 66538 66543 66550 66557 66601 66605.

Afternoon ex. Power station coal empty arrivals were in the hands of: 66520 (4V06) from Ratcliffe, 66550 (4V46) from Rugeley and 66413 (4V22) from Fiddler's Ferry.

The 1304 Cardiff Tidal sidings - Dagenham scrap metal empties was worked by 66618 on this date and has now been recoded back to 6L33 in place of the short lived 6L81 which the train had used.

Some evening engineering train reports (and booked Sunday return workings) were: 66134 - 6W01 1944 Westbury - Margam Moors junction (1100 Bridgend - Westbury return) and 66065 top n'tailing 66088 - 6W02 2014 Westbury -

Pyle (1200 Bridgend - Westbury)

23/09 A late evening 0V14 Westbury - Margam return loco convoy was reported formed: 66053 + 66007 + 66134 + 66206 + 66065.

25/09 66527 was again stabled in the yard. The following Quattro R/Rs were stabled in the car park at approx 11 30: 255 PW 160 940004 - 3, 256 PW 160 940005 - 0, 332 PW 130 ES 940307 - 0, 347 PW 150 ES 940308 - 8 27/09 Over at Westerleigh, 66150 + 60071 were a late arrival noted passing Yate at 0717 on the 6V98 loaded fuel tanks from Lindsey, whilst later in the afternoon 60007 passed Parkway on the 6B33 Theale - Robeston empty fuel tanks. The return morning 4051 Wentloog - Southampton loaded containers were retimed to depart at 1329 and re-coded 4Z51 - 66418 provided the hauling power. 66622 was a light loco move during the morning from Exeter off a new 6V14 2238 (Mon) Cliffe Hill Stud Farm Tarmac - Exeter Riverside (0826) virtual quarry stone. The return is 6M40 1034 Exeter (Riverside) - Stud Farm Tarmac (via Castle Cary 1137) and replaces a to/from Westbury working for the time being. The light engine move is normally booked to Taunton Fairwater for a loco swap.

29/09 The OX12 Margam - Westbury / Eastleigh light loco convoy was reported a runner formed: 66201 + 66047 + 66019 + 66116 + 66097 + 66087 + 66115 + 66199. At 1300, DBS locos 66102 (7W31 0258 Westbury yard - Westerleigh junction, formed with a crane and Falcon JNAs), 66137 (6W30 0135 Oxford Hinksey yard - Yate) and 66145 were all reported in the Wickwar area on engineering train duty. With the line closed north of Yate the 6E41 Westerleigh - Lindsey fuel tank empties were retimed to leave at 1013 and diverted using 60079 and 60099 in a top n' tail formation, being reported passing Westerleigh junction at 1049 (1 late) and East Usk at 1221 prior to a reverse at Newport ADJ, 60099 then taking the train forward solo via Chepstow and Gloucester.

Other freight reports for the day were: 60007 on the 6B33 Theale - Robeston fuel tank empties and 66413 with 6V60 1006 Angerstein Wharf - Cardiff Pengam empty stone wagons.

At 1650 Stoke Gifford sidings held: 66522 66541 66558 66602 with 70015 arriving on 4V46 coal empties from Rugeley PS. 66622 was also noted in the yard during the day.

**30/09** At 1030 Stoke Gifford downside contained: 66413 66541 66558 and 70015 at the head of coal empties. Arrivals later in the day were: 66522 at 1405 as 0Y27 ex. Newton Abbot Hackney yard (off a 6Y27 rail train from Radley) and 66622 + 66601 + 66602 at 1446 as a 0Y14 light loco move from Westbury

**01/10** At 1655 Stoke Gifford downside held: 66413 66522 66557 66601 and 70015 shunting 4F53 coal empties from Uskmouth PS.

02/10 70020 made its debut on the 4V50 and return 4051 Wentloog - Southampton container services the same loco working this train until the 05/10 and reappearing on 16/10.

A woman's body was spotted on the track by a driver in the Westerleigh junction area, closing the line for BT Police investigations, resulting in a number of diversions with First/GW services running via Box and Bath and Arriva XC services through the Severn Tunnel and via Chepstow following a reverse in Newport. 221131 on the 1V46 0707 Manchester Piccadilly - Bristol TM was turned back and noted passing Cam & Dursley at 1204 to run via Gloucester and Chepstow. The following down services 220010 (1V47 0807 Manchester Piccadilly - Paignton) and 220030 (1V48 0644 Newcastle - Plymouth) both ran to Newport for a reverse direct from Gloucester. Road

- bus connections were operating between Patchway and Parkway for diverted Fist/GW HST services and a half hourly shuttle ran between Parkway and Temple Meads with further road buses running to Cam & Dursley. Services were reported as back to normal by 1420.
- **03/10** The 6B72 2136 Avonmouth Aberthaw loaded coal service was failed on the down line in the Severn Tunnel with the loco switched off due to excess smoke and fumes entering the cab. Bi-directional working was introduced late into the evening prior to the movement of the failed freight train onwards by a rescue loco.
- **05/10** At 1230, Stoke Gifford 'downside' held: 66413 66522 and 66622. Later in the early evening 66046 worked the 6042 Halewood Southampton Eastern dock loaded Range Rovers.
- O6/10 The OX12 1244 Margam Westbury (0012 Margam) light loco move was routed via Bath and formed: 66024 + 66039 + 66087 + 66096 + 66201, the latter two having being added at Newport ADJ and only three going onto Eastleigh. Later, 60007 passed Parkway at 1443 with the 6B33 Theale Margam empty fuel tanks. 66413 66622 and 66522 were stabled in Stoke Gifford Yard at 0825. At 1630 Stoke Gifford sidings contained: 66414 66514 66522 66588 66622 66952. 66414 + 66588 had both arrived as a 0C30 light loco move from Bristol Railport at 1133 for week end stabling.
- **07/10** An engineering train report was 66162 at Yate with the 7W38 1000 Westerleigh Westbury yard having arrived in the area the previous evening as 1944 Bescot engineers sidings Yate (2320). The Westerleigh Standish junction mainline was again closed over this date for track work. A late evening return loco convoy, 0V14 Westbury Margam was reported formed: 66162 + 66024 + 66039 + 66087 + 66102 + 66114 + 66186.
- **10/10** At 1500 Stoke Gifford downside held: 66585 66601 66606 66618 and 66619.
- 11/10 66552 was stabled in the yard. 37259 led 37604 passed Bristol Parkway at 1248 with 6M67 Bridgwater Crewe CLS flask
- 12/10 66098 replaced the regular class 60 on the 6V98/6E41 Lindsey tanks, the 1141 return being noted passing Yate at 1152. Two test train were also recorded 950001 passing Westerleigh junction at 1041 on a 2Q08 Didcot Didcot run via Severn Tunnel junction and the NRMT HST formed with power cars 43013 + 43014 working 1Z20 Old Oak Common Derby RTC (via Swansea) passing Yate at 1210 and Cheltenham at 1237 (1 late). The two workings had apparently passed at Pilning with 950001 held in the down loop.
- 13/10 A 30 minute spell at Patchway produced: a 'full house!' 0X12 1106 Margam Westbury light loco move formed: 66185 + 66007 + 66099 + 66121 + 66093 + 66113 + 66046 + 66132 + 66034 + 66013 (at 1416), 60049 (in EWS livery) on 6B33 1212 Theale Margam empty fuel tanks (1419), 66024 up light-engine as 0032 to Dolland's Moor (1419) and 66618 with 6L33 1304 Cardiff Tidal Dagenham docks empty scrap wagons (1429). The 0X12 move was later reported as passing Twerton near Bath at 1445. At Stoke Gifford at 1445 the following were present: 66418 66511 66548 66587 and 66621. 70004 (allox 4Z15/6Z15 Portbury Crewe loaded coal). An evening report and still popular for photographing, Jubilee power car 43186 was noted departing Parkway at 2002 with 43171 on the First/GW 1L92 1823 Swansea Paddington service.
- 15/10 Test unit 950001 was back in the area as 2Q08 1135 Derby RTC Bristol TM passing Yate close to time at 1628. The set was booked to continue at 1807 to Cardiff Riverside (0244) via a number of South Wales

Valley lines.

16/10 Fuel tank train activity through Parkway recorded: 66199 on a 6V96 1348 East Usk - Didcot PS train of 10 TEAs and 60049 which arrived in the down loop at 1607 with 6B33 Theale - Robeston empties. 56311 allocated 6Z16 0604 Port Talbot (Grange sidings) - Acton, passed through the area on a revised schedule (due Acton at 2325), passing Cardiff Pengam 1904, Parkway 2024 and Swindon 2120 (-). 66585 passed Bristol Parkway at 1525 to run around at Chipping Sodbury with 4F56 Uskmouth - Stoke Gifford 17/10 Following a gap of a week, and having powered the loaded logs from Baglan Bay - Chirk the previous day, 56094 worked back through the area as 6Z52 0813 Chirk Kronospan - Teigngrace log empties. Departing Chirk at 0817 (4 late) the train was reported passing Severn Tunnel junction at 1136 (6 early), arriving Pilning loop at 1147 (-) and departing at 1236 (3 early), departing Temple Meads at 1304 (4 late), passing Bridgwater at 1348 (9 early) and Taunton at 1407 (2 early). Other reports for the day included: the 3S59 Barton Hill water cannon passing Pilning at 1115 towards Bristol from South Wales top n'tailed with 66027 + 66126 and 31285 propelling a 3Z13 0934 Tyseley - Bristol Kingsland Road (1759) test train (formed with dept c/stock: 72630 999606 9701) passing Worcester Shrub Hill at 1120 (2 late), Cheltenham 1620 (10 early) and Yate 1647 (26 early). The working had made an out and back run over the Cotswold Line en route reversing at Oxford C.S. (booked 1306-1348). At 1600 Stoke Gifford sidings held only: 66602 and 70014. 66133 was noted departing Westerleigh at 1127 with the 6E41 empty fuel tanks for Lindsey, a second Class 66 to power this train during the month

# Bristol Temple Meads, Barton Hill and Kingsland Road

The review period started with the report that the National Station Inprovements Programme (NSIP) £500,000 allocated work had been completed with the installation of two more self service ticket machines bringing the number to 13, along with work on the station retail outlets and in the toilets. The NSIP scheme which is Network Rail backed has provided £150 million nationwide for station work. News across the tracks from platform 12 and the old Bath Road depot site is that a new £80 million, 12,000 seat concert hall could be opened here by 2016. The latest site plans reveal housing and retail outlets also in the area with a new £6 million connecting river bridge from Cattle Market Road which forms a ink for the Temple Quarter Enterprise Zone. In the meantime seven poly tunnels are to be erected as well as flower beds created on the site by the charity firm Severn Projects which will become a 'urban farm' during the interim 2 year period. A £52,000 grant from the current landowner the Government backed Homes and Community Agency will also be provided and it is hoped to produce organic salad for sale to local businesses. Two new jobs will be created for people recovering from drug or alcohol addiction.

ecs and 1092 return from Bath, some passengers alighting and later being picked up at Westbury for a day visit to Longleat. The c/stock formation was reported as: 99545, Lucille, Ibis, Gwen, Cygnus, Minerva, Phoenix, Perseus, Vera, Audrey, Zena, 6313. On the freight side: 66031 was in charge of the 6C49 empty and return 6B49 1718 Exeter (Alphington Road) - Cardiff Tidal loaded scrap service formed of 18 MBA wagons.

- 21/09 08516 31602 and 47812 were all visible on Barton Hill with 31106 over at Kingsland Road on a test train, during the morning. A not previously reported departure from Barton Hill was overhauled blue/grey Chiltern Railways coach 12119 during the morning of 14/09 by 31602.
- 22/09 43176 + 43003 arrived at St .Phillips Marsh during the early afternoon on a 0Z74 back to back power car move from Laira, 43176 later returning to Plymouth in the company of 43056.
- 24/09 The new week began with a month's rainfall over night! By morning, flooding and line closures followed, with the Bristol Taunton line closed at Flax Bourton (near the road over bridge) and at Uphill junction where a water build up caused a track circuit failure and between Westerleigh junction Hullavington at Chipping Sodbury and at Patchway tunnel around 0830. There were train cancellations, Arriva XC services being diverted via Westbury from the Bristol Taunton mainline where also the road bus substitutions were in trouble with road flooding at Backwell on the main A370 Weston-super-Mare road.
- 47245 worked the final West Coast 5Z35 1034 Kingsland Road Southall ex steam railtour ecs (having brought the inward ecs into Bristol on 22/09) and 31602 departed Barton Hill as a 0Z31 light engine move to Yeovil junction for a 5Z31 1346 stored stock move to Okehampton (1711) via Castle Cary and Westbury (loco run round). The coaches for movement, which had been on site for a long store period in the Clifton Maybank sidings (which forms part of the preservation centre were): 6181, 6002, 5920, 9492, 3354, 3425, 3402. The train, having left the first three coaches for use on the Dartmoor Railway was then booked to depart as 1944 to Taunton, but was noted leaving Exeter early around 1940.
- 25/09 Having arrived earlier on a 3Z06 Derby RTC Bristol test train, 31106 was noted stabled with c/stock: 6263, 62384, 9701 in the bay platform at Temple Meads. A 5Z31 1030 Taunton Barrow Hill train of stored coaching stock, destined for preservation on the Wheardale Railway was cancelled due to the failure of 31602 at Taunton. The train's c/stock was reported as: 9492 (First/GW lined green), 3354, 3425, 3402 (all in former Virgin red). 47812 was rumoured to be the rescue loco, but eventually worked the 5Z47 1335 Temple Meads Eastleigh depot 'Torbay Express' stock ecs passing Keynsham at 1416. This working was initially booked to leave at 1138 from Bristol following a 5Z46 1101 move off Barton Hill depot. 158957 was noted working as a two car set during the day.
- 26/09 56094 put in a second appearance on the Teigngrace logs, the train running as 6Z52 0833 Baglan Bay Teigngrace (1613). The loco had in fact failed during the previous day on Chirk Baglan Bay empties south of Hereford being rescued by 66527 off the 6Z61 Portbury Fiddler's Ferry loaded coal. Both workings were then trapped by flooding! Further problems on the day saw 6Z52 depart late being reported passing: Cardiff Central 1133 (66 late), Filton Abbeywood 1219 (43 late), Parsons Street 1236 (25 late), Exeter 1425 (5 late), Teignmouth 1439 (20 late) and arriving Teigngrace at 1615 (2 late). It was interesting to note how the train recovered time by leaving out a number of booked loop stops. Other

reports for the day were: plain blue 66414 on 4L31 0903 Bristol West Railport - Felixstowe North container terminal and 37194 + 37667 paired on the 6M67 Bridgwater - Crewe Coal sidings nuclear flasks passing Filton at 1320 having departed Bridgwater at 1225.

- 27/09 56094 having run light and arrived Laira depot at 1001 for fuel was declared a failure on the Heathfield branch later in the day whilst working the 6Z53 1441 log train to Chirk. The loco suffered a power problem. A revived failure from two days earlier, 31602 continued the 5Z31 stored coach move onwards from Taunton with a new destination of Chaddesden (Derby), being reported as passing Bridgwater at 1516 and Temple Meads at 1554.
- 28/09  $\,$  66550 arrived at Lawrence Hill at 1711 with 6V87 Crawley Barrow Road stone empties having earlier passed Swindon at 1550 (5 late). 158958 was reported as operating as a two car set when noted at Lawrence Hill at 1743 assumed to be working 2E26 1508 Weymouth Gloucester First/GW service.
- 29/09 First/GW hosted the 2012 Community Rail Event at Temple Meads with various rail partnership schemes throughout the country represented with stalls set up in the station. 150266 + 153380 were used on a series of shuttle services over the Portbury branch (as far Royal Portbury dock, the line's current terminus) and the Henbury loop (between Filton and Hallen Marsh) two local freight only lines which are expected to be re-opened for passengers by 2018 as part of the City Council's 'Bristol Metro' transport scheme which has been provided with the necessary funding by the Government for the new GW Franchise operator to run once this has been decided. Numerous station re-openings are planned to take place as part of the scheme.
- The day's workings were: 2Z50 0905 Bristol TM Portbury and return, 2Z51 1108 Temple Meads - Temple Meads (via Filton - Avonmouth - Clifton Down), 2Z52 1209 Temple Meads - Temple Meads (via Portbury reverse - Temple Meads - Filton - Avonmouth - Clifton Down) and 2Z54 1608 Temple Meads - Portbury and return. The 2Z52 working which was noted passing Pill at 1237 was reported in trouble in the loop at Portbury one of the units having scraped the dock gate! The return was then noted returning through Pill at 1302, Henbury at 1350 and near Sea Mills at 1435 (having lost its booked path to local Severn Beach line services) being booked through Clifton Down at 1351. Track bashers were also disappointed with the working as the train on the return from Portbury used platform 3 instead of the expected 'up through' line! Both the 2Z52 and 2Z54 workings were strengthened with the addition of 150238 (the Class 153 unit, which was the first over the Portbury line, being sandwiched in between), the 2Z52 passing Hallen Marsh at 1533 (2 late) and the 2Z53 arriving Portbury loop at 1633 (3 early) and later Ashton junction signal 337 from 1706 - 1709.

Despite the trains having been advertised as 'sold out' not long after being advertised on the Fist/GW website in August a number of empty seats were observed on some workings later in the day. Also it was noticed Freightliner had provided the freight line pilot man for the day instead of DBS, who covered a similarly routed special in November 2011.

01/10  $\,$  66143 working 6Z66 Acton - Margam four water cannon wagons via the Berks & Hants route dropped off  $\,$  642027 + 642046 at Barton Hill and took 642033 + 642035 onwards for use at Margam. The 2012 water cannon / rail head treatment train duties were scheduled to commence from 04/10 using top n'tail Class 66 locos. Another freight report for the day was 59004 on

the 6C83 Machen - Westbury loaded stone being reported through Bath around 1420.

- 13/10 A Saturday check for the Bristol based water cannon confirmed the morning diagram as that of last year being noted with 66027 + 66126 top n'tailing 3S59 Barton Hill Barton Hill (via South Wales and Hereford) passing Newport at 0910, arriving Pilning up loop at 0944 (26 early) and departing 1036 (5 early), passing Henbury at 1052, Shirehampton 1145, Hewish level crossing (near Weston-super-Mare) at 1228 and returning here at 1254 for Bristol. Back in the City, at St.Phillips Marsh an out of use First/GW 08822 was noted stabled near the wheel lathe carrying the unofficial name John.

- 12/10 70004 passed East Usk with 6F53 Newport Docks Uskmouth coal at 1425, this then formed 4F57 empties to Stoke Gifford. This loco earlier worked 4C05/6F65/4F52 Stoke Gifford to Portbury to Uskmouth
- **13/10** An impressive 10 locos on the Margam Eastleigh today, passed East Usk at 1330. The convoy was 66186 + 66007 + 66099 + 66121 + 66093 + 66113 + 66046 + 66132 + 66034 + 66013
- 17/10 70099 arrived into Newport Docks this morning on the MV Sudkap. This was a demonstrator loco built in Turkey a few years back when GE thought they could break into the European market in the same way that GM did with the 66. Upon arrival one end of the loco was numbered DE37001 but this was renumbered on the dockside today. Hauled by 66561, 70099 passed through Newport at 1913 as 0Z25 to Craven Arms where it was due to pick up a cripple wagon, before carrying on to Crewe as 6Z25
- **18/10** 70014 passed East Usk with 4F52 Uskmouth Newport Docks at 1120. It had earlier worked 6F65 Portbury Uskmouth
- 19/10 66602 dragged 70014 and 6F65 Portbury Uskmouth into East Usk Yard at 1045 just over 4 hours late. 66602 then hauled 70014 passed East Usk at 1215 heading east, not sure where it ran around as they did not do it in

East Usk, possibly turned on Maindee Triangle. The loaded wagons had been left in the yard from where 66585 arrived at 1450 to take the train down the branch. The loco ran past first however, seemingly to pick up a shunter at Newport. Normally the driver does the run around uncoupling / coupling up. 66301 passed East Usk at 1300 heading to Wentloog with 4V38 Tesco liner.

However the Railway Touring Company 'Welshman' (1282 0635 Poole Cardiff Central and 1283 1714 return) with 70000 Britannia, a West Coast operation was a runner being reported as passing: Trowbridge at 1027, Bath Oldfield Park 1100, Lawrence Hill 1115 ( ), Patchway 1128 (6 late) and the return: Llanwern West junction 1737 (7 early) and Pilning 1814 (1 late). C/Stock in use was recorded as: 35465 (loco support), 99127, 99125, 99712, 99121, 99350, 1860, 4951, 99318, 99723. This trip was redated from 29/09/12.
- 23/09 The final 'Royal Duchy' (1Z34 0848 Bristol TM Par and 1Z35 1745 return) of the 2012 Season was hauled by 34067 Tangmere. It remains to be seen whether this train will operate in 2013, as it was run this year by the Railway Touring Company to fill in for a shortened Bristol Weymouth series of workings due to the Olympics being held in the seaside town and engineering work on part of the route.
- 03/10 A Torbay Express Ltd 'Bath Spa Express' (Poole Bristol TM and return) trip was cancelled.
- 13/10 34067 Tangmere worked a Railway Touring Company, West Coast operated 'Bath & Bristol', 1Z94 0944 Victoria Bristol TM (1411) and 1Z95 1704 return (2112) outing which had been re-dated from 16/09/12.
